The year of release mentioned may not be the year the recording was originally made, it can sometimes be the year the LP was re-released on CD. Where known, the original date is given.

# Three New Theatre Organ CD's



These three CD's were recorded at Uncle Milt's Pipe Organ Pizza Company in Vancouver, Washington. Now closed, it used to house a beautifully restored Wurlitzer 3/18 theatre pipe organ, now in a private residence.

**Skip O'Donnell's** love for jazz started when as a kid playing trumpet he was introduced to the jazz styling of Louis Armstrong and listening to the big bands of Count Basie, Stan Kenton and Shorty Rogers and his Giants.

Before his trumpet playing, he had four years classical piano training and when he was twenty he started to break into the music business. He went to buy a piano to put into a club, but the salesman showed him a Hammond B-3 which he ended up buying.



In the eighties when the B-3 sound was no longer mainstream, he changed to a grand piano and kept the Hammond for concert work.

During his travels he got the chance to play many pipe organs including the Wurlitzer 3/13 in the Crown Theatre, Pasadena where he played in the mid-1970's. Prior to that he played and recorded on a Gulbrandsen Realto Theatre Organ and owned a couple of them. In 1991 he discovered Uncle Milt's and played there until its closure in June 1999.

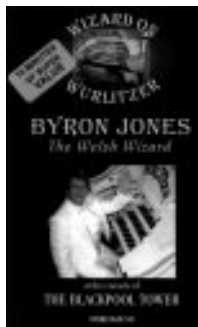

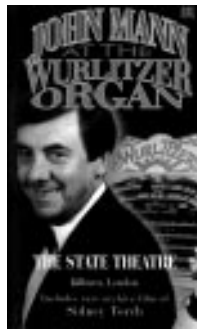

# ORGANISED KEYBOARDS by Alan Ashton

In my organ festival days I recall many happy times when it was a great privilege and pleasure to introduce to the audiences, organist Mike Hall. He had style that was unique and refreshing, and the sounds he extracted from the Elka range of organs was something individually enjoyable. Traces of it can still be heard on **INTO THE FUTURE [ACD218]**



but the instrument is the Lowrey MX2. The title is almost a decade old, and that goes for the recording as well, but don't let that put you off because every collection should have at least one Mike Hall recording amongst it. The organ has two 61 note keyboards: a full pedalboard and 10 presets. In total there are 15 tracks on this CD which originates from the Audicord catalogue and is now available, alongside a selection of other recordings from the same source, from MSS. The CD content is best described as a typical Mike Hall performance, minus the crazy introductions with which he linked his programme together. Items such as A FOGGY DAY / THIS MASQUERADE / AROUND THE WORLD / STAR TREK THEME / STARDUST and a jazz-rock version of OLD DEVIL MOON all played and recorded in his home studio without aid or need of a safety net... in other words he never puts to any use the inbuilt disc drive feature. On ALEXANDER'S RAGTIME BAND

he does however make great use of the auto-backing feature, and on a couple of tracks WHAT FOOL AM I and VARSITY DRAG he transports the listener to any one of the huge American movie palaces as the mighty Kimball organ rises from the darkened depths. The latter item is the more authentic sounding of the two, and would take a lot of beating when it comes to musical impersonations. Speaking with Mike recently, more in the hopes of expecting him to indicate he had a new recording available, he went on to say that after a short partnership with Gem organs (they having pulled out of UK sales) he has returned to the concert circuit playing his faithful Elka, which he's 'souped up' to bring more up to date sounds. Other tracks include: WALKING MY BABY BACK HOME / RAINY DAYS & MONDAYS / IN A LITTLE SPANISH TOWN / MEDITATION / THEY CAN'T TAKE THAT AWAY FROM ME and from the famous Michael Jackson 'Thriller' album THE LADY IN MY LIFE. Also available is Mike's earlier album HIS MASTER'S CHOICE on which he plays the Elka C1000.

From the same Audicord stable there are a couple of great recordings made by one of my favourite lady organists, Doreen Chadwick. **MANCHESTER GAUMONT MEMORIES [ACD 216]** makes me realise my age



because it was back in 1972 when the LP first came out on the Amberlee label, and yours truly wrote his first set of sleeve notes. The famous WurliTzer organ was still in the theatre (now all that remains is a grotty City Centre car park) and the performances display the fact that this was one of Doreen's most favourite organ installations. The organ itself no longer remains in its original form, having been lost in a fire, only to rise, phoenix like from the ashes in an almost identical copy which can be seen and heard daily at the nearby Granada Studios tour complex. The original organ was a strident and fiery beast, instantly recognisable to BBC Light Programme listeners... O' happy days!

Commencing with her own special signature tune, DOREEN, what follows are some typical items which to this day the artist still includes in her well received concert engagements, namely any number of tunes made famous by the great THOMAS 'FATS' WALLER / some PETULA CLARK HITS, a selection from the film SINGIN' IN THE RAIN, the PUNCH & JUDY POLKA and one of my own personal favourites, the march THE PHANTOM BRIGADE. If you want to turn back the clock and listen to one of the finest WurliTzers ever to leave the North Tonawanda factory, then this CD is the one to go for. Much the same can be said for another organ that in its hey day was instantly recognisable... certainly when it was under the command of the late Sidney Torch. Like the Manchester installation, the Christie organ of the Regal, Edmonton has long been moved to a new home. Some four years after her session at Manchester, Doreen travelled South especially to record this

fiery British built organ. If my memory isn't playing tricks with me I seem to recall this session was at the request of an American record company. Quite a number of the items are loud and up beat: THE PARROT SAMBA / RED PEPPER RAG / LA CUMPARSITA / THAT'S A PLENTY and the march UNDER THE DOUBLE EAGLE.

To single out an item from the programme I guess I would go for the selection from the film I'LL SEE YOU IN MY DREAMS... one of my all time favourite films starring the lovely Doris Day. Did I have a crush on her... didn't I just. So to hear either instruments in the cinemas for which they were specifically designed, there are no finer examples than either of these two archive recordings.

Two interesting additions to the MSS catalogue are **ERNEST BROADBENT ENTERTAINS [MMD1067]** and **HAMMOND EVERGREENS [MMD1024]** which features American organist **EDDIE LAYTON**. Ernest Broadbent of course needs no introduction to audiences in this country, and in the early days of long playing recordings, neither did Eddie Layton. Eddie has always been associated with the



Hammond organ and a number of his recordings made their way over here on the Mercury label. However, this is one of two recent

recordings he's made, and for someone who must now be well into his 70's, you would be amazed at how well he still makes the Hammond 'talk'. American football audiences in the giant New York Stadium get a chance to hear Eddie and his Hammond, amplified to a colossal degree, every time the Yankees Team play at home. Eddie still relies more or less on standard Hammond organ sounds, and all the effects that you will hear are derived from his skill at manipulating the drawbars. The selection of tunes are from the days way back when the accent was as much on the words as the music. And with such a feast I suggest you turn to your last newsletter and look at the programme on offer and don't think twice about adding this disc to your collection of must haves. As for the **ERNEST BROADBENT** release, well in keeping with many theatre organ



music lovers, he will always be my favourite when it comes to playing the Tower Ballroom organ, but on this occasion it's back to the City of Manchester, for that's the location for a programme of music that features some of his recordings made on the WurliTzer organ that used to be in the Free Trade Hall. The interesting thing about this release is that some of the tracks are appearing for the very first time and although they were made at a time when Ernest

was not in the best of health, they do nevertheless show the unparalleled skills of this sadly missed artist. Once again, the complete list of tunes, which do indeed have something for all musical tastes, can be viewed in the last newsletter.

Bargain basement time this time around is undoubtedly **THE MAGIC COLLECTION [MEC 949038]** a compilation of recordings by Klaus Wunderlich



on the ARC records label. The 16 tracks cover a whole gamut of his legendary recording career and include early Hammond organ tracks **STRANGERS IN THE NIGHT** and **WONDERLAND BY NIGHT**, the latter harkening back to those days when distinct left and right channel ping-pong stereo was in its infancy. His experimental period with the moog synthesizer is represented with **RAINDROPS KEEP FALLING ON MY HEAD**: there's his famous version of **TICO TICO**, then **IN THE MOOD** from his Gold Award Glenn Miller album: **BRAZIL** comes from any number of the Latin American volumes, and the remainder are mainly European pop medleys featuring his famous Wersi organ sound. This release would appear to be identical to that of the English Pickwick release [CN 2068] and contains a couple of compositions by the artist, a play he often

successfully used in order to pad out three or four part medleys when there was nothing else commercially on offer. At just under an hours running time and with a price of only £4.95 (and just £2.95 for subscribers) you can't go wrong with this one.

No sooner had that Klaus Wunderlich compilation arrived in the MSS storeroom than two more re-issues appeared. Once again it's all down to Werner Kohlhammer who, in conjunction with Bell Records seem to be slowly and methodically working their way through the Wunderlich music collection. In my letters to Werner Kohlhammer I have always made a point of suggesting that the very early Wunderlich recordings are far more likely to enjoy good sales figures based on the theory that for a number of years, those prior to the emergence of his Hammond Pops series, many people had no real idea just who he was. His early Hammond recordings are brilliant and if you don't believe me then just snap up a copy of **48 FILM AND OPERETTA MELODIES YOU'LL NEVER FORGE [BLR 89 096]**



This compilation is actually two complete and separate recordings originally released as 24 FILM MELODIES YOU'LL NEVER FORGET subtitled GOLDEN FILM HITS Telefunken

SLE 14566-P and 24 OPERETTA MELODIES YOU'LL NEVER FORGET Telefunken SLE 14753-P. The great thing about both those LP's were that each side was recorded in continuous medley format... no annoying breaks between tracks. All those early recordings have long disappeared and unless a collector has been extremely careful with them, they too must now be showing their age. Fear not, because with modern day technology the original master tapes have undergone a transformation to wipe out all traces of magnetic tape background and the resultant sound is as good, if not better in dynamic range, than it was back in the 70's when these two recordings first reached these shores. The 24 FILM MELODIES contains the themes from some of the most famous film world releases: LIMELIGHT / A MAN & A WOMAN / GOLDFINGER / NEVER ON SUNDAY / WHAT'S NEW PUSSYCAT? / ZORBA'S DANCE / HARRY LIME THEME & THREE COINS IN A FOUNTAIN to name but a handful. If you love the lilting melodies of Franz Lehár, Johann Strauss, Emmerich Kálmán, Robert Stoltz & Paul Lincke, then all these famous composers are represented on the 24 OPERETTA MELODIES segment. Everything from DIE FLEDERMAUS to VILJA, KOMM ZIGÁNY & VICTORIA AND HER HUSSAR. There is no finer playing of a Hammond organ than as demonstrated on this superb CD. If your musical tastes lie in other directions then I am sure there will be something for you to enjoy on **SOUND 2000 [BLR 89 097]** To save confusion I should point out that this is not the Wunderlich recording of the same title on Telefunken SLE 14715-P



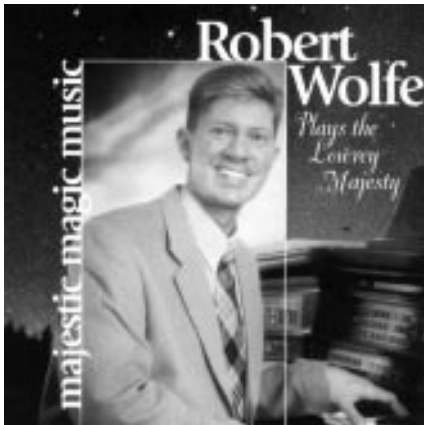
which was released during his experimental moog synthesizer and electric piano period. However the CD does contain a few tracks from that correspondingly titled LP. For fans who constantly ask to hear something new from the Wunderlich archives, myself included, then you're in luck. Making their first ever sound outings are a full version of RIVERS OF BABYLON, previously only heard as a portion of a three part medley: the BERLIN MEDLEY Parts 1 & 2, and another of his own compositions WUNDERBAR... not to be confused with the tune of the same name from Kiss Me Kate. In between these tracks there are further examples of his legendary Wersi organ sound ie: STRING OF PEARLS and a couple of his POP HITS MEDLEYS. From his early Hammond days comes another of his own compositions HIGHWAY SPEED which to be honest has been included on a number of other Wunderlich compilations and re-releases. Sales of all these Bell Musik releases prove that despite his early passing, the music of this sadly missed super star is still as popular as it ever was.

Dare I say it?. We have both a new Robert Wolfe and a new organ sound, and what a welcome combination it proves to

be. **MAJESTIC MAGIC MUSIC [WPCD02]** gives a hint of a clue in as much as the organ he makes

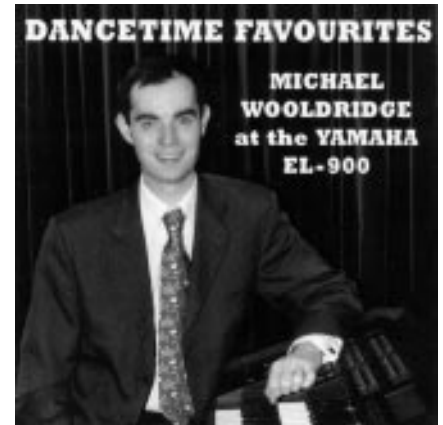


his debut upon is the Lowrey Majesty. I seem to recall that some many years ago Robert did occasionally tote around with him a WurliTzer electronic, but as far as recordings on electronics are concerned, this is his first. I have to ask myself if I am at last beginning to tire of the pipe organ scene, because Phil Kelsall and Nicholas Martin, both best known for their WurliTzer pipe organ performances, are also a darn sight more entertaining on electronics, for me at least. It doesn't seem like 20 years since I first heard Robert record the Opera House, Blackpool WurliTzer, but for the better part of those past two decades he has been resident at the Thursford Collection WurliTzer. The opener to this new CD is a very lively up beat threesome A FOGGY DAY / NICE WORK IF YOU CAN GET IT / S'WONDERFUL, and quite honestly I could have done with few more examples of this exciting style scattered throughout the CD. That isn't to say the remaining 14 tracks are any the less so. Three tracks down the line Robert features some beautiful tone colours in TO A WILD ROSE. To suddenly find that with electronics he can programme the rhythm patterns that he would otherwise have to

'drum' up from the WurliTzer pipe organ has allowed him to concentrate more on musical accuracy and interpretation. MEMORIES OF YOU which is sandwiched between SO NICE and the old Seekers number THE CARNIVAL IS OVER is the first indication that the Lowrey Majesty does indeed have some majestic sounds, and certainly the model has a great improvement of sound over its predecessors. The same comment applies equally to BELLS ACROSS THE MEADOW, a descriptive old 'warhorse' from the pen of Albert Ketelby, and which no self respecting cinema organist of the 30's would have failed to record or include in their repertoire. To say the least I find some of Ketlebys works very dated, and others have me reaching for the skip track button. One of the numbers, I'LL STRING ALONG WITH YOU, brought back memories for me when, in my more youthful cinema projectionist days, I fell in love with 'the girl next door'... yes, you've guessed who. Warner Brothers star Doris Day. If I recall this lovely tune was from one of her first films, It's Magic. There is a nice four part country and western medley and a similar numbered 30's medley prior to the album closer, MY WAY which will be forever associated with the late Frank Sinatra. The only gripe that I have with this CD is in the rather mean running time... almost 20 mins less than the norm. Space being at premium prevents me specifically commenting upon all the other equally nice tracks, so my final comment has to be the fervent hope that Robert continues to record the Lowrey Majesty in the future.

Strict Dance tempo recordings continue to arrive in about as many numbers as illegal

immigrants seeking asylum in this "easy money" society of ours, but because in the past I have commented on the majority of those released on the Maestro strict tempo label, I thought for a change I would single out a new one from Michael Wooldridge titled **DANCETIME FAVOURITES [MPCD 105]**. Michael uses the new Yamaha EL-900 throughout



the 20 tracks which are compiled for strict tempo or sequence dancing. Nothing startlingly new in the choice of programme, except the playing is a little more on the theatrical side, which is not surprising considering that the artist won the prestigious American Theatre Organ Society Young Theatre Organist award back in 1980, and four years later the Ian Sutherland Award presented by the COS. Michael is resident at the Worthing Pavilion where he plays for the Tuesday afternoon tea dances, but there are shades of the sadly missed Tower Blackpool Ballroom organist Ernest Broadbent playing the waltz FASCINATION... the famous 'hand over' tune which heralds the appearance of the WurliTzer theatre organ when used for their dance sessions. This new EL-900 organ does seem to be a popular choice of instrument and despite the restrictions on the music, Michael manages to utilise it to full potential, and all the tracks are

played without any multi tracking, sequencing or editing. So, whether it be Worthing, Blackpool or the local church hall, enjoy the whole range of sounds of big bands, orchestras and theatre organs, as Michael plays music from films & stage shows: 42nd STREET / STRIKE UP THE BAND / WE'RE IN THE MONEY / TEA FOR TWO / CHATTANOOGA CHOO CHOO / APRIL SHOWERS / MEMORY / THE BLUE DANUBE / CRUISING DOWN THE RIVER / WHAT'LL I DO / ALWAYS. For those of you who like to hear just what Michael can do whilst seated at a WurliTzer then I can certainly recommend his 1985 recording which he made at the Gaumont State, Kilburn.

Those of you who enjoy the exciting Continental style and sound of the electronic organ need look no further than a sampler CD produced by Andreas Mautner, husband of organist Claudia Hirschfeld and head honcho and editor of the German magazine OKEY. With a couple of exceptions all the artists appearing on **KEY SENSATIONS Vol.1 [CD 00016-2]** have all

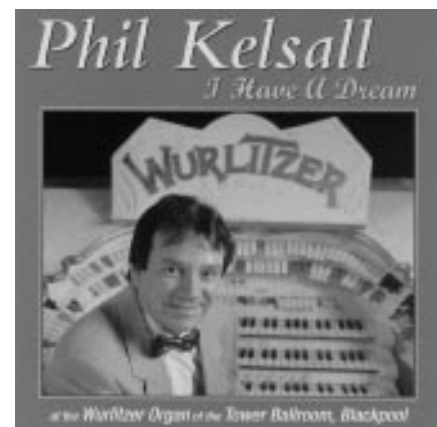


appeared on earlier releases from Manual Music, also the brainchild of the aforementioned organ world personality. The two newcomers are Catherine Drummond, a very talented young

organist who I first heard a couple or so years back, and remember enjoying her performance immensely. Her contribution WHEN I FALL IN LOVE is taken from her UK produced album INTERMEZZO. The other is Daniel Watt, a fellow Northamptonian, who I vividly recall in early Pontins organ festival days, had a determination, bordering on obsession that knew no boundaries when it came to climbing the organ world ladder of recognition! His contribution, specially recorded for the album comes from the recent film ZORRO, and is the main theme I WANT TO SPEND MY LIFETIME LOVING YOU. On the scale of the performance the determination paid off Daniel! None of the featured instruments are credited but there is certainly a large contingent of Böhm & Wersi models scattered throughout the 16 tracks. Top performer Claudia Hirschfeld is allocated three tracks, including the CD opener which she featured in her last UK tour: MOLIENDO CAFÉ, and Mark Whale offers LOVE BIRD and the Elton John pop classic CAN YOU FEEL THE LOVE TONIGHT. Artists Robert Bartha, Thomas Gulz and Dietmar Wolf play their own compositions but the one that I found to be the most exciting was COURSE OF TIME composed and played by Jürgen Merkle. It immediately brought back memories to me of the theme from that long running British TV programme 'Wickers World'. Other artists are Thymo Meyer who plays MOVIE STAR, Tina Sartorius with IN THE GHETTO, Stefan Georgi with MY HEART WILL GO ON from the film Titanic, Christoph Klüh with ROCKING AFFAIRS and a very nice arrangement of the Errol Garner classic, MISTY from Marc Zeberg. If there are any

comments on this album it would only be to suggest that future releases in the series could perhaps indicate which instruments are being played, together with brief biographical notes on the artists. Other than that this is a CD full of contrasting styles, not all of them too modern in approach that they cannot be appreciated by people of all ages.

Not only has Phil Kelsall a new video on release, but his annual offering from his seat of residence at the Tower Ballroom, Blackpool can be enjoyed with the purchase of **I HAVE A DREAM [GRCD100]**.



Having released a recording each year for the past quarter century seated astride the WurliTzer's red velvet organ seat, not to mention recent annual electronic organ releases, such recorded output must soon be heading for the Guinness Book of Records. I find myself asking how he finds new items to include but for certain there are four in this delightful 64 minute programme. The first comes early on in the form of AVE MARIA composed by Guillio Caccini back somewhere in his lifetime of 1546 - 1618. As Phil suggests in his usual informal but comprehensive sleeve notes, the tune, which I think is a first on any theatre organ recording, does have a touch of the Jerome Kerns about it. Incidentally, I do wish more organists would take the time and

trouble to provide interesting sleeve notes, instead of leaving the inner covers blank. How much more effort does it take to write half a dozen lines about each tune? Very little. BLACK-EYED SUSIE, not to be confused with PRETTY LITTLE BLACK-EYED SUSIE, comes from the pen of Phil's record producer, Bob Barratt: REACHING FOR THE MOON is a hauntingly beautiful tune from the pen of Irving Berlin and was one item which former Tower Ballroom Ernest Broadbent often used to play in his concert programmes, and lastly the CLOG DANCE which has found fame with brass bands and is featured in the film *Brassed Off*. Talking of brass bands I'm just waiting to see which organist will be the first to record the music from the popular BBC programme *Ground Force*. No Phil Kelsall recording would be complete without a good selection of happy Blackpool requests, and so for good measure there's a couple of contrasting SCOTTISH GEMS, a trio of ABBA hit numbers, a quartet of DRINKING SONGS. Also on a more serious note Phil has included the lovely hymn HOW GREAT THOU ART, which will revive memories for many people of the spectacular Songs of Praise television broadcast made at the Tower, HEYKENS SECOND SERENADE and the descriptive IN A MONASTERY GARDEN which, despite an excellent musical portrayal is one tune that I believe has well had it's day as far as organ recordings are concerned. For a finale Phil turns back the clock to his very first LP... hands up everyone who still has a copy... and signs off with his signature tune THANK YOU FOR THE MUSIC.

Now when it comes to really putting a WurliTzer through it's

paces with a programme of Classics, then William Davies with **A RETIRING COLLECTION [CDHLW 1006]** has got to be one



of the best CD's of this genre for a long time. Many years ago I recall one of the popular Spanish organ festivals I was connected with, and Bill had been engaged to come and play the organ in Malaga Cathedral. Permission having been granted from some very high ranking church officials, it was unexpectedly made known to us that the organ console was of such an old and unique design, that the black and white keys were reversed and that only certain specially written organ music could therefore be performed on it. With only days to go, Bill Davies dusted off some early manuscripts from his vast personal collection, and gave a concert that brought forth great praise from all the Festivalgoers, but more especially from the highly respected Cathedral organist who had no idea that a visiting organist could just walk in, sit down and perform at such an individual console. The CD in question here was recorded a couple of years back at the WurliTzer in the New Victoria Centre, Howden le Wear. (For specific details of the installation please refer to page 10 of Issue 6) Opening with the rousing march THINGS TO COME by Sir Arthur Bliss, and closing with

another march CROWN IMPERIAL by William Walton, the 9 tracks sandwiched between include a beautiful 16 min performance of music from CARMEN, the complete CHILDRENS OVERTURE by Roger Quilter: that wonderful musical anthology of nursery rhymes. For good measure there are a couple of items which Bill is rarely allowed to leave a concert without playing, namely the SCHERZO from A MIDSUMMERS NIGHT'S DREAM by Mendelssohn and the SCHERZO from CONCERTO SYMPHONIQUE by Litoff. These are but a few of the calibre performances from one of our most highly acclaimed elder statesmen organists who, in keeping with the CD title has now almost retired from the concert circuit.

To be fair the title is not very original but the playing by 26 year old German artist Christoph Klüh is most certainly full of **INSPIRATION [MSS 018]**. Classically trained from a very

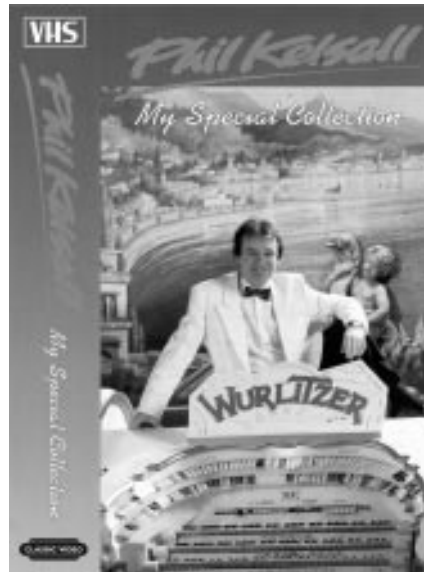


early age he turned his attentions to the electronic organ some 10 years ago, and his artistic flair and musical interpretation using the Wersi Spectra CD700, an OX7 expander, the Performer Plus and CG2 Digital grand piano, all make for a very exciting CD. One of my favourite films in recent years was

FOREST GUMP but this is the first time I have heard the delightful theme music recorded by any organist. It's a somewhat laid back CD opener which suddenly changes direction with the next track. Drawing on his classical background we have PRIMO SINFONIA, one of two very 'meaty' self penned compositions, although to be fair I did find the core theme to be somewhat repetitive. The next track is the CD title which also appears as the CD closer, albeit as a shorter and slightly reworked reprise. BAYWATCH fans will enjoy the theme from the outstanding (in more ways than one!) TV show, and GAMES THAT LOVERS PLAY enables Christoph to recreate the orchestral sound of its composer, James Last. Three tracks feature a whole battery of Latin American instruments CARNEVAL BRAZIL / EL CUMBANCHERO and LATIN INTERMEZZO which is performed as a bass and percussion solo. Delving back to his classical training again, there are excellent performances of two famous pieces by Grieg: ANITRA'S DANCE and a wonderful musical sound picture of IN THE HALL OF THE MOUNTAIN KING. It was that frightening I had to put the office light on! Other tracks include FAME / ALF'S THEME / ROCKING AFFAIR and THE WAY I LIKE IT. A very enjoyable CD from start to finish.

When it came to releasing organ videos one of the pioneer artists was Phil Kelsall and over the years I have had the pleasure or reviewing a number of them. This latest one see's a departure from the former Blackpool production outlet to the Dorset based Classic Video company who appear to specialise in some interesting



travelogue productions including a number based on steam railway journeys around Dorset, Swanage and Eastleigh. Ironically, and don't ask me why, but steam trains and organ music have always seemed to go hand in hand and judging by the excellent production that this video is accorded, it could be an ongoing and successful partnership.

The problem with any organ video is some sort of storyline or theme to encompass, in this case, 60 minutes of sound and vision. As one of our most travelled organ stars, Phil has chosen the Worthing Wurlitzer, the Harrison & Harrison organ in his old school Chapel at Rossall, Blackpool, his own Technics SX-FA1 shot against the glorious background of the Spanish Hall in the Blackpool Winter Gardens and his own seat of residence without which any video would be incomplete, the Blackpool Tower Wurlitzer. It is this location that sets the opening scenes with some interesting shots of technicians setting up the stage in preparation for his annual gala concert. With some judicious editing the viewer is given the impression that the Tower

excerpts are all filmed live on that occasion, but the reality is otherwise! Like a magician "now you see it now you don't" the stage is miraculously clear of video projection screens and associated paraphernalia, thus allowing the camera operators to set lighting and move around the console un-inhibited by interruptions to the audience sight lines and their visual enjoyment. The added bonus is that the background sound is cough and sneeze free!

The Tower organ shots are nothing out of the ordinary but at least the console and artist are not bathed in a garish purple and blue colour combinations. There are limited close up manual shots, the emphasis being on the left and right of the full console. Thankfully someone has taken the time and trouble to light the ballroom architecture so that for once you can get an idea of its majestic beauty. The same credit must go to the lighting of the Spanish Hall and I doubt that it has ever been shown with so much clarity before. This location serves as the backdrop to the Technics portions of the video and includes the THEME FROM TITANIC which presents an ideal opportunity to overlay archive still and movie shots of the construction and subsequent departure of the fated liner.

Archivist Brian Crompton sets the scene for the section featuring the organ in the Empress Ballroom which, having long been removed, is represented with historic shots of the late Horace Finch and the interior of the building as it is today: the scene of many a Political Party Conference. Next we are off to Worthing where, in complete contrast to the previous guest, the dour Jim Buckland, Chairman of

the Sussex Theatre Organ Society relates, the story of the WurliTzer installation in the Assembly Hall... a mini Tower Ballroom sans the architecture. Phil is seen at the console playing for dancing and vox pops testify to his popularity as an expert in both dancing and concert performances. These are intercut with a long queue of autograph hunters being marshalled into line outside his Tower dressing room.

Next it's off to Phil's old school at nearby Rossall School where he meets up with his old Music Master Arthur Lingings, and after a brief demonstration of the Harrison & Harrison organ, Phil plays I VOW TO THEE MY COUNTRY. The final segment of the video alternates between the Tower and the Moorish setting of the Spanish Hall where, during CRAZY there are some delightful

intercut sections with Phil and his young daughter on a day out in Blackpool's famous Stanley Park. My one feeling is that these sections would have been far more appropriate if overlaid during his subsequent playing of YES, MY DARLING DAUGHTER.

The finale is IT DON'T MEAN A THING IF IT AIN'T GOT THAT SWING, and this would appear to be latest musical candidate for the rhythmic and show stopping manual to manual technique beloved of the general public, and known to aficionados as waterfalling. The video closes with some shots of Blackpool beach, a nice backdrop for the technical credits... all of whom must take a well deserved bow for a production that has something for everyone, be they organ music lover or not. The presentation box cover shot shows Phil in a relaxed

mood sat atop of the Tower WurliTzer, but nowhere was I able to find an indication of the correct sound format. Other tracks include: TRITSCH TRATSCH POLKA / GLAD RAG DOLL / MACK & MABEL selection / BYE BYE BLUES / MORNINGS AT SEVEN and AMPARITO ROCCA.

Well my luvlies, this marathon session was compiled in between a move to a new house at St Austell and although I won't have time this year to go topless on the lovely beaches, I'll just pass on a tip given to me in the local pub by an old Cornishman. When I broached the subject of basking sharks he said:

*"Remember boy... a shark will only attack you if you're wet"* Bye for now!

# Profile of Donald MacKenzie



Donald MacKenzie was born in 1970, in Irvine, Scotland. From an early age he was given a thorough grounding in piano and then progressed to the classical organ. In 1988 Donald was appointed the resident organist to the Glasgow Garden Festival.

In 1991 he was the winner of the Senior Young Theatre Organist of the Year in the ATOS international competition. This won him a trip to San Francisco to play at the convention. He also played in July for the ATOS international convention.

In November 1993 Donald was engaged by the Walt Disney Company to play the organ at the Odeon Leicester Square, London for five weeks playing the 'Duchess' Compton organ before each performance of their film, 'Aladdin'. He also appeared throughout the run of 'Lion King' and in 1995 during 'Pocahontas'.

He has been featured several times on radio which has included broadcasts on the BBC World Service and BBC Radio 2's "The Organist Entertains", as well as being featured in Empire film magazine. He recently appeared on a number of television

programmes in connection with the reopening of the Odeon.

Throughout 1996 he was very much involved with the celebration of 100 years of cinema. The events included a celebration of 100 Years of Film on the site of the Odeon, a special celebration service in St. Martin In The Fields, where Donald accompanied de Mille's epic film "King Of Kings". He has appeared at both the

50th and 52nd Royal Film Performance in the presence of Her Majesty The Queen.

Donald also played all the organ music in the Aardman Animated Film ' Stage Fright'. This film won the 1998 BAFTA Award for best Animated Film.

When he's not playing for concerts Donald specialises in the accompaniment of silent movies and already has played for some of the major classics of the silent screen; The Phantom Of the Opera, Dr. Jeckyl and Mr. Hyde, as well as many different types of short silents.

Donald has just recorded a musical video for OS Video, featuring not only the Odeon Leicester Square, but the many wonderful architectural features to be found in the cinema. His most recent CD, 'At The Odeon', was recorded for Sterndale Records, especially to mark the Odeon Leicester Square's 60th birthday and the recent refurbishment scheme of Rank's flagship Odeon cinema.

At present he is studying at Goldsmiths College, London University for a music degree.

He also has an interest in steam trains, tram cars, and enjoys going to orchestral concerts and the opera.

## THE ODEON LEICESTER SQUARE

The site of the Odeon Leicester Square has been used for entertainment over the past 150 years. The 'Royal Panopticon' was replaced by the Alhambra Theatre, and in 1936 Oscar Deutsch acquired this in order to build his new flagship cinema for the Odeon circuit.

The wonderful art-deco Odeon Cinema was opened on the 2nd of November 1937 with the Royal Premiere of "Prisoner Of Zenda" starring Ronald Coleman. The Odeon was complete with just over 2,000 leopard-skin covered seats, fully equipped stage with rising orchestra and organ lifts and the latest in projection equipment.

The Odeon Leicester Square has become known throughout the movie world as 'The Cathedral', and over the years has hosted many galas and royal premieres. Akin to any cathedral, it boasts a magnificent organ. Built by John Compton in 1937, with 5 manuals and 17 ranks of pipes, as well as a complete range of percussion instruments, it is installed in two spacious chambers beneath the 47 foot wide screen. There have been only three full-time resident organists at the Odeon - James Bell, John Hewlett and Gerald Shaw, the latter remaining until his untimely death in April 1974. Gerald gave the instrument the affectionate name, "The Duchess", by which it is still known. Since November 1993, the organ has been featured many times by the current 'house organist' Donald MacKenzie.



# Profile of Donald MacKenzie

In 1967 there was a most 'unfortunate' redevelopment scheme, when much of the original 1937 decor was destroyed. In April 1998 the Odeon closed for a £ 3.5 million refurbishment scheme and reopened its doors on the 5th of August 1998 with the Gala Premiere of "Armageddon". The present scheme has combined 'the best of the old with the best of the new'. This has included the recreation of the 'flying figures' on the proscenium wall, the reintroduction of 'leopard-skin' style seating, and outlining the black granite exterior and the famous 120 foot tower in neon. Complete with the very latest digital sound and projection equipment, other improvements include a glass staircase, a celebrity balcony, and 47 miles of fibre optic cable have been used for special lighting effects.

The Odeon remains a London landmark and a beacon in the world of film entertainment.

## THE 'DUCHESS'

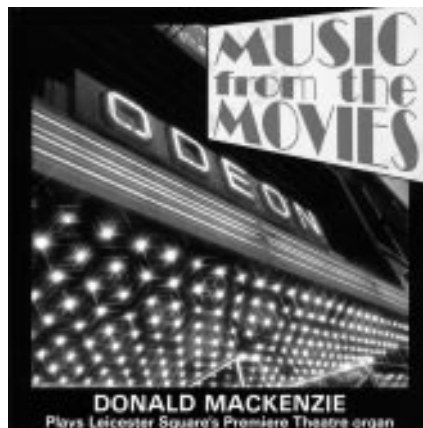
The 'Duchess' has 17 ranks (or sets) of pipes, and numerous percussions. These are controlled by the unique 5 manual console.

The console's glass surround was specially designed by the architects to reflect the swirls and curves of the auditorium walls.

The two spacious chambers contain all the pipework and effects that the 'Duchess' needs to make her wonderful voice heard throughout the auditorium.

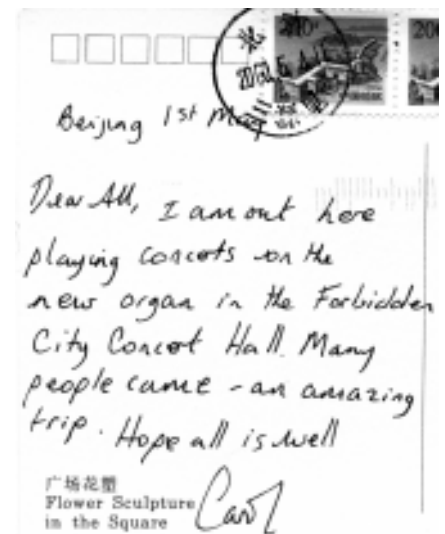
The first concert, at 7:30pm on Friday April 28th 2000 was with the Beijing Symphony Orchestra conducted by Tan Lihua and Carol played a varied program to

highlight the outstanding versatility of the new organ. It included popular works by Widor, Bach, Jeremiah Clarke, Franck, and Purvis together with lighter music by Scott Joplin, Sousa and British composer David Hellewell. It culminated in the Saint-Saens Organ Symphony in C minor.

The second concert at 7:30pm on Sunday April 30th 2000, was devoted entirely to the organ and, to cover a wide range of interests, the first half was made up of famous classical works whereas, in sharp contrast, the second half was principally of very popular works. This concert was filmed for an impending documentary release and, in addition, there were numerous interviews with magazines and with television.

The new concert hall is some five minutes walk through the beautiful gardens of the Zhang

Shan Park adjoining the famous Tiananmen Square. Beijing as a whole is well developed and very much up to date yet, surprisingly for a country which is the third-largest in the world, we were given to understand that it has only four pipe organs. The visit and the success of Austin Organs in their installation therefore represent a truly historic and memorable event.

# Profile of Eddie Ruhier



Eddie Ruhier was born in Horncastle, Lincolnshire on May 5th, 1950, and grew up there in a house full of music. The living room would be echoing to the sounds of both the classical and tyrolean music his Swiss father loved so much; his mother would be listening to Winnifred Attwell in the kitchen; traditional jazz would be filtering down from his brother's bedroom upstairs; his sister would be dancing to pop tunes on her record player in her room, and Eddie - from age 5 - could be found hammering away at the old upright piano in the front room.

Teaming up with a schoolfriend who played drums, Eddie played piano on Clavioline (a small keyboard which fitted underneath the piano keyboard) at a local pub - then, on a visit with his parents to Southend, he saw a Kimble electronic organ in a music shop. His father bought him the organ, and Eddie set about teaching himself to play the pedals. Again with his drummer friend, he began to play at RAF camps around Lincolnshire, now using the Kimble.

When he was 14, the two did a summer season at Skegness, and then, visiting another organist friend in Bradford who was resident organist at the Silver Blades Ice Rink there, Eddie was approached by a Director of Mecca Ltd., who asked him if he'd ever considered playing the organ for Ice Dancing.

That was the start of Eddie's long career in Ice Rinks - after training in Streatham rink, he

took up residency at the Silver Blades Rink in Birmingham, where he stayed for 26 years - with time off to play on several Cunard liners - including the Princess, Countess and the QE2.

On his first day on the QE2 he blew up the C3, (an American, 120-volt model), by plugging it into the ship's supply, which was 240 volt. The smell of melting transformer wax and the clouds of black smoke alerted him to the fact that something was possibly wrong and as the ship was already at sea, he had to play a Fender Rhodes electric piano until a little man from Barbados could be brought aboard to fix the organ.

By now Eddie was playing Hammond organs - he had two: a T200 and an L100 - and the organs in the Ice Rinks were all C3's. It was the start of a lifelong love affair with the Hammond. He still has the L100, although he now uses one of a pair of X5's with Leslie 760s.

Eddie moved to Huddersfield in 1988, where he now lives with his partner Dave, two white cats and

two dogs. He has a recording studio in the cellar, in which he records CD's for Grosvenor Records, and also music for Ice Dancing.

In his spare time he rides his beloved motorbike - a Kawasaki ZZR600R - in black leathers and big boots, generally frightening the local population. He once turned up to play a theatre organ concert in Solihull on the bike, and the caretaker wouldn't let him in, refusing to believe that this dangerous-looking biker had actually come to play the organ.

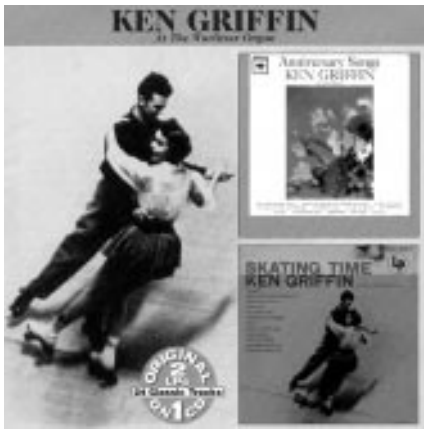

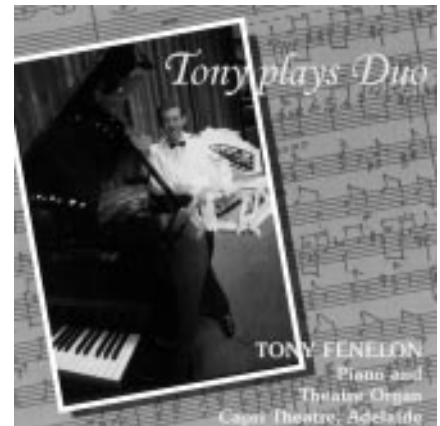
